Call to Order & Prayer: Meeting was called to order at 5:30 pm by Jackie Evans, Council Chair. Fr. Swamy provided the opening prayer.

Agenda Approval: Agenda was reviewed and approved.

Review and approve minutes from January 17, 2023, meeting: Motion was made by Deacon Scot Berkley to approve the minutes as written. Shirley Schultz seconded the motion and all approved.

- Confirmation will be April 19, 2023, at 7 PM at St. Joseph Church. Sacred Heart has approximately 30 confirmands.
- Brittany Boubin is now on maternity leave and Caroline Nelson has stepped into her role in the Religious Education Program until Brittany returns.

Old Business:

- Canopy Input A summary of the survey will be placed in the bulletin within a couple
 of weeks. The final decision will be made by Father and an action plan will be
 implemented, if approved.
 (Bruce Louks, parishioner in attendance, was seeking an update and stated that
 - people are curious about the process and outcome.)
- Tabernacle Campaign The tabernacle is now delayed and will not likely be delivered prior to Holy Week.
- Celebration of Fr. Swamy's 30th Anniversary of Ordination May 3, 2023.
 We will celebrate after Mass on Saturday, April 29 and Sunday, April 30. The Serra Club will host fellowship after the Sunday Masses and Bill and Marie Lawrence will host after the Saturday evening Mass. The Serra Club would also like to make ordination cards with an image and prayer, to be blessed by Fr. Swamy and handed out at the celebration. An announcement will be made at Mass, inviting all to come and honor Father on this milestone.
- Announcing songs at Mass- Ray Bissen inquired about announcing songs at Mass in addition to having them posted on the electronic display board. Fr. Swamy has observed parishioner participation in singing and has found there is no difference if it is announced or not.
